- 02. Visva-Bharati reserves the right not to fill up the vacancies if circumstances so warrant and withdraw any advertised post(s) at any time without giving any reason.
- 03. The eligibility of an applicant shall be determined in accordance with the UGC Regulations, 2018 and its subsequent amendments from time to time.
- 04. Candidates must fulfill essential qualification / experience on the last date of application. All educational qualifications must have been obtained from recognized University / Institute only.
- 05. Essential qualification / experience prescribed are the minimum and mere possession of them will not entitle an applicant to be called in for interview.
