Vidyasagar University invites application from Indian Nationals for filling up of the following posts:

1. Medical Officer: 1 (One) Post (Unreserved)

Revised Pay: `79,800/- (Level – 12) and other allowances as admissible.

## Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

- (i) MBBS degree from recognized University affiliated to Medical Council of India.
- (i) At least 10(ten) years' experience of medical practice in a Government / Military / Quasi Government hospital.
- (ii) Registration Certificate from West Bengal Medical Council or Medical Council of India.
- (iii) Age not below 35 years. Relaxable in the case of exceptionally qualified candidates.
- (iv) 10(ten) years' experience in hospital may be relaxed in case of private practice of reputation for 15(fifteen) years

### Desirable:

(v) Post graduate Degree in any of the branches of Medical Science or Diploma in Public and Tropical Medicine.

NB: The applicants who have already applied for the post of Medical Officer against the Employment Notification bearing No. VU/R/Advt./04/2022 dated 13.05.2022 are requested not to apply again. However, they may send their updated bio-data along with supporting documents.

2. Audit Officer: 1 (One) Post (Unreserved)

Revised Pay: 57,700/- (Level – 10) and other allowances as admissible.

## Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

- (i) Uniform good academic record with a Master's degree in Commerce / Finance with minimum 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the point scale wherever a grading system is followed.
- (ii) At least 5(five) years of working experience in Supervision, Control, Planning and Management of Accounts and Audit, preparation of budget in Government, Quasi-Government or University or Commercial Establishment.
- (iii) Age not below 30 years. Relaxable in the case of exceptionally qualified candidates.

### Desirable:

- (i) Chartered Accountant or Cost accountant or Business Management Degree
- Assistant Professor (Purely on contract basis) in Computer Science: 02 (Two) Posts (Unreserved).
   Consolidated pay (Pre Revised): Rs. 21,600 and other allowances as admissible.

## Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

## For Assistant Professor:

a. Good academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Masters Degree

- level in a relevant subject along with relaxation applicable to specified categories as explained in the **Note-1**.
- b. the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like NET/SET along with exemptions to specified categories as explained in the **Note 2**.

## Note-1: Relaxation of Marks for Recruitment of Assistant Professor:

- i. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate and Masters level for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Differently-abled (physically and visually differently-abled) / other Backward Classes (non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing food academic records during direct recruitment to teaching positions. However, differently-abled (physically and visually) candidates are not eligible for any marks relaxation in Physical Education discipline.
- ii. The minimum qualifying marks of 55% is relaxable by 5% marks (from 55% to 50%) at the master level for Ph.D. degree holders who have obtained the Masters degree prior to September 19, 1991.
- *iii.* The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- iv. All the essential qualifications must have been obtained from a recognized University/ Institute. By a recognized University/ Institute is meant a University/ Institute affiliated to UGC / other statutory apex bodies, or recognized by the State or Central Government as a centre of higher learning. In case of a foreign University, the Degree concerned should be recognized as equivalent to its India counterpart by the Association of Indian Universities.

## Note-2: NET/SLET/SET Exemption for the Post of Assistant Professor :

- i. The candidates who have been awarded Ph.D. degree in the same or in a relevant subject in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the qualifying in the Eligibility Test (NET/SLET/SET).
- ii. Candidates registered for Ph.D. programme prior to 11 July, 2009 shall be exempted from qualifying in the Eligibility Test (NET/SLET/SET) as described hereinafter. The award of Degree to candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/ Bye laws/ Regulations of the institutions awarding the Degree in the same or relevant subject shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET /SET. Subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:
  - a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
  - b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
  - c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
  - d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a referred journal;
  - e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences, seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.
- f) (a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs)/Dean (University instructions).

iii. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Master's Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

# 4. Medical Assistant (Purely on hiring service basis): 1 (One) Post (Unreserved).

Pay: As per the norms of the University

### **Essential Qualifications:**

M.Sc. in Biomedical Laboratory Science and Management or M.Sc. in MLT or Bachelor in MLT from any University or University approved institute recognized by Central/ State Government or GNM from any institute approved by Indian Nursing Council and West Bengal Nursing Council or by State Nursing Council other than West Bengal.

**Desirable:** Post qualification experience for 6<sup>th</sup> months in the field of sample collection, sample analysis, patient care and patient monitoring. Working knowledge in computer handling.

- 4. In case of Substantive posts, the appointment will be made initially for a period of 1(One) year. Based on the performance they may be regularized in the post.
- 5. The direct recruitment process in the post of Professor and Associate Professor will be made following the state Government Order vide No. 516-Edn(U)/1U-91/10 dated 16.05.2017.
- 6. Age limit for the post of Associate Professor and Professor as per the latest UGC Guidelines in this regard.
- 7. The period of time spent by the candidates to acquire M.Phil and Ph.D degree shall not be claimed or considered as teaching/research experience for appointment to the post of Associate Professor.
- 8. OBC-A, OBC-B, SC, ST, EC certificate, (as the case may be, if applicable) issued by the competent authority of Govt. of West Bengal only, will be considered.
- 9. Persons employed in Government / Semi Government Organizations / Autonomous Bodies should submit their application through proper channel. They may, however, send an advance copy of the application. Those who are unable to process their application through proper channel may submit 'No Objection Certificate (NOC)' from present employer during the time of interview. However, they should submit an undertaking to that effect. Direct application from such candidates will not be entertained.
- 10. Age relaxation for SC/ST/OBCs/Ex-Serviceman and Persons with Disabilities (PWD) is applicable as per Government norms. Age relaxation is also applicable those are working atVidyasagar University.
- 11. Candidates should submit their SC/ST/OBCs/ Ex-Serviceman, Disability Certificate issued by Competent Authority in the prescribed format along with the application form, in support of their claim.
- 12. The University reserves the right of rejecting any or all the applications without assigning any reasons thereof.
- 13. Candidates applying for more than one post may apply separately for each post.
- 14. Mere eligibility will not vest any right on any candidate for being called for interview / written test. The decision of the University in all matters will be final. No correspondence will be entertained from the candidates inconnection with the process of selection. Canvassing in any manner would entail disqualification of the candidature.

- 15. Incomplete applications or applications without self-attested copies of certificates or received after the last date are liable to be rejected. The University reserves the right to conduct the written / screening test, if the number of applicant is large for a particular post.
