Essential Qualification : Post-graduate degree in Fisheries Science (or) Marine biology (or) Environmental

Science/ (or) equivalent. (Candidates having post-graduate degree in Basic Sciences (i.e., 3 years Bachelor's degree and 2 years Post-graduate degree should have NET qualification/ NET qualification not mandatory for 4 year's

bachelor degree).

Desirable Qualification : Experience in Marine research, Fishing technology, Experience with Research

Methods; Analysing ecological data using relevant software & writing research papers. Candidate must be willing to travel to different locations along Kerala coast for collection of fish catch data and go onboard regularly in the commercial/departmental fishing vessels. Occasional visits outside Kerala are also

required as part of project work.

Age : Maximum 35 years for men and 40 years for women as on date of interview. Age

relaxation of 3 years for OBC candidates and 5 years for SC/ST candidates is

permissible.
